Once in a Blue Moon Meaning Very rarely infrequently Example We only go to that restaurant once in a blue moon Visual Imagine a blue moon a very rare celestial event thats how infrequent something is How to use it Use this idiom to emphasize the rarity of an event or occurrence 8
